During the past 2 years of the Covid pandemic the Bike Project saw a big slowdown, like most other things. 2020 raised about \$450 and 2021 about \$900.

2022 is off to a more promising start. So far, over 50 bikes, trikes, scooters, etc., were donated to four local thrift stores in Manitowoc and Two Rivers. About 10 bikes were repaired and returned or donated, to the Haven. 28 bikes were picked up by Lutheran Ministries to be delivered to the Salvatorious in New Holstein. They will be included in their next overseas shipment.

Sales and repairs are ongoing. All profits are donated to Hope House of Manitowoc County. –Tove Alecksen




